Thanks to **CASA of Walker County** for sponsoring the July Business After Hours. CASA of Walker County has been providing advocacy to abused and neglected children since 2005 and currently serves 100% of the foster children in Walker, San Jacinto, & Trinity Counties. Training Coordinator Janet Davidson shared, "A CASA volunteer is assigned to one child or sibling group that is currently in the care of the state. Our advocates help reunite these kids with healthy parents or help find an alternative forever home. The volunteers make sure that the kids know they are loved and seek what is in their best interest. Most advocates give about 15-20 hours of their time each month visiting the child, communicating with all the parties in the case, and bringing recommendations and concerns before the judge. Around 50% of our CASA advocates work full-time so much of the time that they give volunteering fits around their schedules. We need men to fight for children, women to nurture young hearts, young adults to set examples of excellence, grandparents to share their wisdom.....we need YOU!"
