Augustine Tolton, Ex-Slave and First Black Catholic Priest in U.S., Takes Step to Sainthood

Augustine Tolton was born into slavery in Missouri in 1854, escaped to freedom as a child during the chaos of the Civil War, and later became the first African-American priest in the Roman Catholic Church.

This month, he took the first step toward becoming the Church's first African-American saint.

Pope Francis put Father Tolton on the path to sainthood Wednesday when he issued a decree "declaring the heroic virtues" of the priest, who was the only American on the list, which contained the names of eight candidates for sainthood.

Bishop Joseph Perry of the Archdiocese of Chicago called Father Tolton "a bright light in a difficult period of this nation's history."

"His life and ministry still speak to the problems of our day where communities, neighborhoods and churches continue to evidence separations among race and class and the disturbances that erupt periodically from these social contradictions," Bishop Perry said in a statement. "Father Tolton is a model for priests and laity who live and work in these situations while they strive to work for harmony and peace among all regardless their color, their origin, their language."

There are two more steps on the road to sainthood. If church investigators attribute a miracle to Father Tolton, he will be beatified and declared "blessed" by the Pope. A second miracle would lead to his canonization, which would make him a saint.






