What is Drydock Beer Garden?

This is a seasonal outdoor space that has a beer garden atmosphere, where non-profit organizations can raise money while advertising/promoting the organization and selling water, pop, beer and wine. It's a great place to meet some friends, family and listen to music.

Who can attend?

This is open for everyone. Alcoholic beverages will only be sold to those age 21 and older.

Where are you located?

Downtown Bay City (next to Mulligans) 113 Center Avenue, Bay City, MI 48708

Where do I park?

Any parking space downtown that is available, typically most people park by the Planetarium or on Water Street.

Do I need to purchase a ticket to get in?

No! No fee is needed to get in. Money is only needed to buy drinks/chips/raffle items.

What about the weather?

Outdoor heaters are available, if it is raining hard- each organization may close early due to poor weather. Keep checking the Facebook page.

Can we bring in food?

Yes, we encourage that you support the local downtown restaurants by getting take out. Come, sit and enjoy your meal outdoors while purchasing beverages at Drydock to support our school.

Are there bathrooms?

Yes!

What are the hours?

Each organization fits the hours that work best for them.

Typically they are 2 hours shifts.

Volunteers will pour beer or wine and grab bottles of water or soda. No mixing of drinks is required. Cash and credit cards are accepted. Volunteers will ring people up at the cash register, sell raffle tickets and keep things tidy (throw away trash, wipe down tables, tidy up bathrooms).
