ELIGIBILITY

- JUNIOR OR HIGHER COLLEGE STUDENT
- BANKING RELATED MAJORS

The George Harding Scholarship was founded in 1984 by the Michigan Bankers Association and the Michigan Traveling Circus to award scholarships to college juniors or higher in a finance or banking related major. These two groups consist of members supporting Michigan banks.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION

1. Student must be a Michigan resident seeking at least a four-year degree.
2. Full-time student (12 or more credit hours per semester for undergraduate or nine credit hours for graduate students)
3. Attending a Michigan or out of state college or university. Student must retain their Michigan residency.
4. Degree must support the banking industry; i.e. finance-related; business administration, economics, agriculture, accounting, IT, marketing, etc.
5. Student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher.
6. Scholarships are provided after successful completion of sophomore year or higher.
7. The student must show leadership qualities and be involved in campus activities.
8. Applications must be received by **July 15** of the academic year for which aid is sought.
9. Funds are paid directly to the college or university for credit to that individual's tuition expense.
10. Past recipients are ineligible.
