We would like to express our gratitude to Rev. Dr. Barber for allocating \$600 from her discretionary fund for this purpose and the fellowship (Guatemala Companion) committee of St. Martin-in-the-Fields for allocating \$1,000 from the special projects fund for this epidemic.

Thank God the epidemic has ended at the Baby and Mother's Home.

Currently, only a few babies remain with common respiratory infections.
