December 3, 2023, 2 to 3:30pm at the Philadelphia Museum of Art

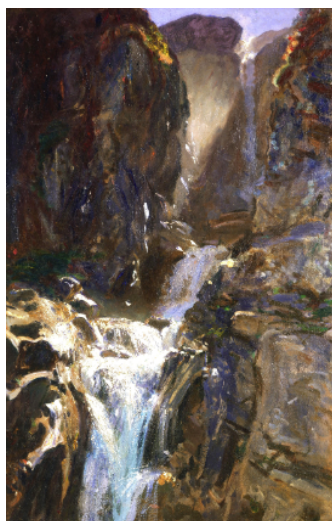
Cost: Sliding scale with a suggested price of \$25.00 (Admission and parking are free)
