She will emphasize their appearance, size characteristics, and other interesting information that will help you decide where Natives might fit into your home landscape or other areas on your larger properties.

Janet lives in Little Rock. She has her BS and MS degrees from the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville. Janet began her career as a county agent in Pulaski County covering all aspects of horticulture. She began the Arkansas Master Gardener program in 1980. Upon completion of her Masters Degree, Janet moved to the Arkansas Extension Service office as the statewide Horticulture Specialist. She retired January 2, 2019 after 38 years with the Cooperative Extension Service. She continues to write a Saturday weekly column in the Arkansas Democrat-Gazette and a monthly column in Arkansas Living magazine, along with a blog, **Plan It Janet**. She leads garden travel programs, and now gets to spend more time in her own garden. Her first book, *In the Garden*, was published in 2010, and her second book, *Field to Feast*, was published in 2016. Janet is married with two grown children and two dogs.
