PRETEEN COMEDY – MALE OR FEMALE PART
THE THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM

CYNTHIA

RAY

CYNTHIA

RAY

CYNTHIA

You asked me out a few days ago. You're paying. So...this is a date. Number two.

RAY

Will there be a third date?

CYNTHIA

I'm not sure. We'll have to see how tonight goes.

RAY

So let me get the rules straight. If I pay it's a date, as long as I asked you in advance of our meeting.

CYNTHIA

Pretty much.

RAY

And if I pay three times do I get a prize or something?

CYNTHIA

I'm not a prize. Well, I mean, I am...but not the kind that can be bought and sold. You have to treat me special.

RAY

And how do you treat me?

CYNTHIA

You'll just have to wait and see on that third date.

RAY

Listen, I think we should pay for our selves tonight.

CYNTHIA You want me to pay for myself?

RAY

You got it.
