Prescription Mail Delivery

RxP has piloted a new mail delivery option – sending the prescription medication to patient homes for FREE during this crisis.

Reduces the risk of exposure for patients, staff, and volunteers while ensuring that vital medication is received in a timely manner by patients with chronic conditions.

RxP’s programs also support the increased medication demand at 32 clinic partners (85 localities) throughout the state as a result of COVID-19.

Providing 90 day supply of product to reduce costs and increase medication adherence. Patients can speak to a pharmacist with any questions.

One patient with an underlying autoimmune condition was extremely grateful to not have to come out in public if she didn’t have to.



"We had insurance. My husband had his own business and then he had a massive stroke. **We lost everything** - I didn't go to the doctor for years because I couldn't afford it.

I wouldn't be sitting here right now if it wasn't for the medications."

We need support to help us continue providing this critical service

Rx Partnership is seeking \$25,000 to purchase generics and provide shipping of medication free of charge to low-income, uninsured patients in Virginia. These patients are 18-64 years old, on average have 3 chronic conditions and take 5 medications.

The dramatic increase in unemployment means MORE patients in need.



Moving Forward

- ▶ Each year, RxP provides 50,000+ prescriptions to low-income, uninsured patients throughout the state.
- ▶ We anticipate RxP will incur a significant expense purchasing and mailing prescriptions as needed during the crisis.
- ▶ We are currently sending patients their prescriptions through priority mail at an average cost of \$7.02 per mailing.
- ▶ We would like to offer this service in the future, if needed due to the patient's transportation and/or health challenges.
- ▶ In the first week alone: 4 clinics mailed 84 packages! We anticipate a **HUGE** increase in utilization May - July.
