

Please follow these procedures for a safe worship experience for all. This applies to those who have been vaccinated as well. Thank you

The following procedures have been implemented to make your attendance safe in accordance to CDC guidelines.

- Everyone will wear a mask.
- For those parishioners who do not want to attend the in-church service, the service will be broadcasted on Facebook.
- Entrance to the sanctuary will be only through the parking lot narthex door and **not** the preschool/office/portico doors.
- Available by the inside door will be a sanitation station with hand sanitizer and additional masks.
- Offering plates will be on a stand located inside the door at the narthex entrance to the sanctuary.
- Seating will be every other pew which will allow 6-foot separation and restricted rows will be marked with a blue “X”.
- Attendees may sit on the outside side of the pews, but no parishioner will be allowed in the center of the row.
- Families in the same household or travel companions will be encouraged to sit together.
- On communion Sunday, communion elements will be provided.
- Since the hymnals will be removed, the congregation can, with their masks on, sing the hymns printed in the bulletin.
- During the “Passing the Peace” there will be no hugging or hand shaking; instead, a wave and words of peace and welcome would be appropriate.
- During the “Children’s Time”, all children will remain in the pews.
- After the service, an usher will dismiss the parishioners by rows starting from the back of the sanctuary.
- After being dismissed from the sanctuary, parishioners should leave the church to prevent any potential virus contamination.
