

We appreciate you following these safeguards in order to protect those in our church who are unable to be vaccinated or are at higher risk. These simple gestures demonstrate the love and care we have for each other and our neighbors as a community of faith.

- **As of September 1, 2021, masks are required inside the church building.**
- Entrance to the church will mainly be through the courtyard door; those who need a shorter walk due to mobility issues or weather may be dropped off at the portico door.
- Seating will be every other pew which will allow 6-foot separation and restricted rows will be marked with a blue "X".
- Attendees may sit on the outside side of the pews, but avoid the center unless directed by ushers.
- **During the "Passing the Peace" please do not leave your seats, shake hands, or hug;** instead, greet others with a wave and words of peace and welcome.
- During the "Children's Time", children may come forward with parent's permission. Children should stay in their family groups, and the children's time leader will help seat them at a safe distance.
- After leaving the sanctuary, parishioners should proceed outside.
