



Good Wheel 2020 Itinerary

The Good Wheel bike ride is a genuine and unique Israel experience which includes a 5-day trip with a 4-day 150- to 200-mile bike ride through biblical Israel, shoulder to shoulder with Israeli riders, many with disabilities. The 2020 Good Wheel Bike Ride will take place October 19 – 24, 2020 starting in the northern Negev desert and ending near Eilat.

- **Monday: October 19:**

- Arrival in Tel Aviv
- Commemorate the ISCD's 60th anniversary with a celebration at the Center
- Meet the Good Wheel participants and enjoy a special dinner
- Hotel in Tel Aviv or near Beer Sheva

- **Tuesday: October 20: Bike**

- Cycle through the beautiful Lahav Forest in the northern Negev Desert together with hundreds of Israeli riders. Enjoy beautiful landscapes, archaeological remains and desert wildflower

- **Tuesday: October 20: Tour**

- Hike around the pastoral oasis, Yerucham Park. See and learn about the blooming flora unique to the region and the development of the area in the last 70 years
- At the UNESCO World Heritage Site, Mamshit, hear the story about the Nabatean people and explore ruins of what as a wayside stop and developed into a city on the famous Incense Route.

- **Wednesday: October 21: Bike**

- Bike through the hills of the central Negev from the city of Yeruham to Mitzpe Ramon via the Ramon airbase



- **Wednesday: October 21: Tour**

- Nahal Havarim & Uin Uvdat: Hike through a desert canyon to a stunning oasis. At the end of the hike there is an uphill climb on ladders
- Ben Gurion Grave: Hear the story of the first prime minister of Israel, and see his final resting place against a beautiful desert backdrop
- Visit the Mitzpe Ramon Visitor's Center

- **Thursday: October 22: Bike**

- Ride from Mitzpe Ramon to Ketura

- **Thursday: October 22: Tour**

- Hike from 2-3 hours through the Ramon Crater
- Visit the Amunite Wall with amunite fossils which show remains for a sea that was once there.
- Enjoy the Neot Sadar Tour if time permits. Entrance fee applies

- **Friday: October 23: Bike**

- Ride south from Neot Smadar along the Egyptian border to Eilat

- **Friday: October 23: Tour**

- Hike along a narrow canyon lined with swirling gorgeous reddish sandstone. The colorful and narrow Red Canyon gorge is one of the finest examples of geological color variety in the Eilat mountain range

- **Friday night: October 23: Shabbat dinner and program**

- Enjoy a wonderful Shabbat dinner and program with fellow Good Wheel participants, ISCD staff and athletes

- **Shabbat: October 24: Conclusion of Good Wheel 2020**

- Closing Good Wheel program to be determined
- Transportation to the local Eilat airport will be provided
