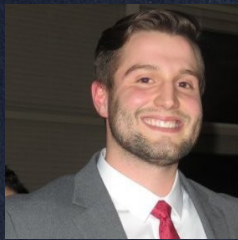


What's News in the SobelCo Nonprofit World
