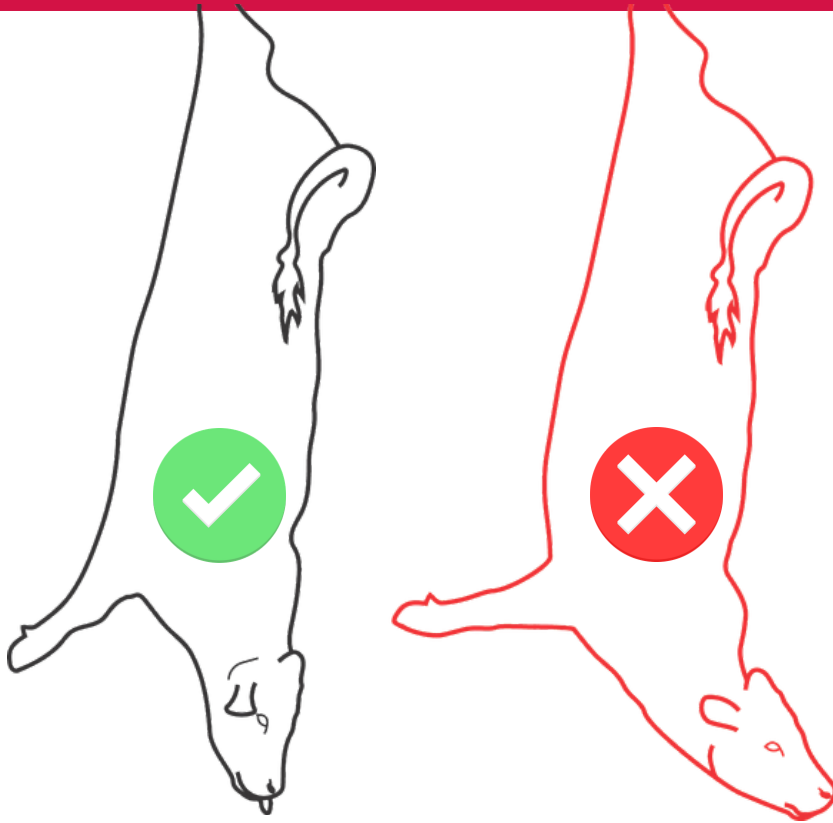


Righting Reflex

Always check for a corneal reflex (a blink when you touch the eye) immediately after stunning!

Another key sign we continually monitor to determine insensibility is called a 'righting reflex'.

If an animal displays a righting reflex, they are definitely sensible.



INSENSIBLE

- Floppy head
- Floppy neck
- Tongue *might* hang out



SENSIBLE *RE-STUN IMMEDIATELY*

- Animal will try to 'right' itself and try to position their head so it is horizontal or parallel with the floor
- Arched back
