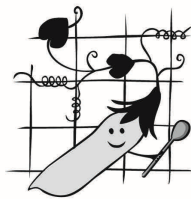
Jeff Smith would love the thought of your spending time on a real farm --- learning about how you can work and care for the beautiful land here in your own community.

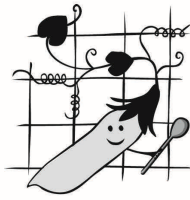
