To kick off April Child Abuse Prevention Month, join us for the virtual Premiere of *Find Your Village*, a 16-minute documentary filmed in Phoenix about strengthening families through connection and community.

All families need support and connection, both in times of need and in everyday life. But to some parents, seeking support and connection might feel uncomfortable, or even dangerous. Others may simply not know where to go to find what they need.

Through a collaboration of the School of HipHop, Prevent Child Abuse Arizona, and lived expert leaders of Thriving Families Safer Children Arizona, and with funding from the Annie E. Casey Foundation, the documentary *Find Your Village* was created. The film focuses on why we must shift our culture to one that supports families rather than surveils them, and how families can get trusted support and connection through Family Resource Centers.

This session will begin with an introduction to the film, followed by a screening, followed by a Q&A with the film's creators.
