- We are thankful the Salvadoran government has just passed a care reform law that will emphasize family-based alternatives for vulnerable children and hopefully streamline the child protection process. Project RED, part of Katie's work, has been advocating for many of these care reforms.
- You can join us in praying that local churches here would continue to grow in their knowledge, passion, and commitment to caring for orphaned and vulnerable children and families. We are hoping to help recruit and train at least 5 more foster families this year as part of a pilot program.
- There has been an uptick recently in gang violence here, which had been on the decline for the past few years. While we are relatively quite safe, please pray for all those most impacted by the violence, and that the Prince of Peace would reign in the hearts of those who would wish to do harm.
- After 2 years of homeschooling, Riley and Eliana are so excited to be back in school. They really like their school, and are thrilled to be with other kids. We pray they grow in wisdom and kindness, and closer to Jesus each day.
- Our foster son Jose just turned 2, and is a delight! We were blessed to be able to celebrate with his biological grandma and 2 of his bio siblings. Please pray for his family of origin and for us as we navigate those important relationships.
- Jeff is transitioning into a new role with Horizon, and in addition to supporting their programs in Guatemala and Honduras, he will be working with Horizon's team in Kenya as well. Most of his work is virtual, but he has had to travel already a lot this year and has some more trips coming up. Please pray for safety and for their team as they work through many organizational transitions now.
