December Food Distribution

Each month, *Light of Christ* shares food and kindness with our community as part of *Nourishing Hope's* network of six churches. We distribute nearly 100 food boxes—no sign-ups, no qualifications, just a warm welcome.




On the second Monday of each month, our *Truck* Bosses pick up a trailer, load collected empty boxes (thanks to our friends at the liquor store who call us the Happy Church), and deliver them to Our Father's Lutheran in Rockford. There, volunteers from six churches pack about 700 boxes with fresh produce, dairy, and more before reloading them onto trailers for distribution. In the afternoon, volunteers gather at Light of Christ to unload, sort additional items (like milk), and prepare for distribution. Before opening, we pause for introductions, scripture, and prayer. As we serve, we collect basic info from recipients and offer prayer cards. Our volunteers are a true blessing, sharing not just food but kindness and care. At day's end, we pray over the submitted prayer concerns before passing them to Pastor Tim so our whole church can lift up our neighbors in prayer. You're invited to serve! Sign up at links below:

CHILDREN, YOUTH & FAMILY NEWS




YOU ARE INVITED to our Light Up the Night event on December 10th from 5-6:30 PM, which includes a Maker's Market as well. Our Voyager and Pathfinder children are putting a lot of work and effort into the task of creating the Christmas story in pictures in the Fellowship Hall windows. We invite you all, young and old, to come and celebrate the beginning of the Christmas season with us. This will be an outdoor event, so please dress accordingly. There will be freshly baked waffles and hot chocolate for a free will donation. This donation will be used to pay for bus transportation during caroling and other Children and Family Ministry expenses. Our kids' groups will sing some of their Christmas program songs as well. As a special surprise for all attending children, we will have a special visitor. After learning of the origin story, we will get a visit from St. Nikolaus (not Santa Clause, but looks the same), who will bring nuts and oranges for the children. Why do we call it Light Up the Night event? Besides having warming fires we will also reveal the beautifully painted, colorful windows by lighting them up in a ceremonial way for everyone to see and enjoy. Maker's Market: this combined event offers 'children' of all ages (0-99) the chance to showcase their talents - whether in crafting, baking, or other handmade creations. All children and youthaged participants are able to sell the products of their craft skills in a maker's market style. If you enjoy making jewelry, pottery, soap making, story writing, drawing, book binding, baking, clothes designing, or any other kind of crafting you have the opportunity to set up a table and showcase your products. You will be in charge of either bringing a table or borrowing one of ours, setting up, decorating and tearing down your own shop. It is an outdoor event, so please plan accordingly. Be mindful of the time of day - evening, when it is dark out. You will have to provide lighting for your 'booth,' like battery operated light chains, fully enclosed candle lanterns/battery powered lanterns, or shop lights. We won't be able to provide electrical outlets for everyone. So please plan on using battery powered options.
