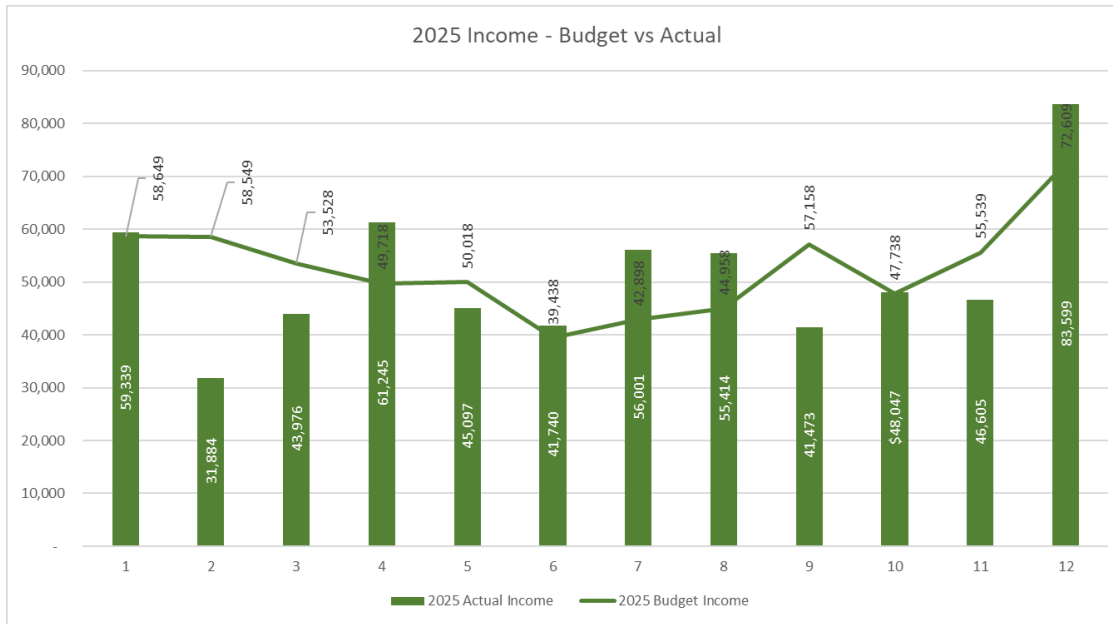

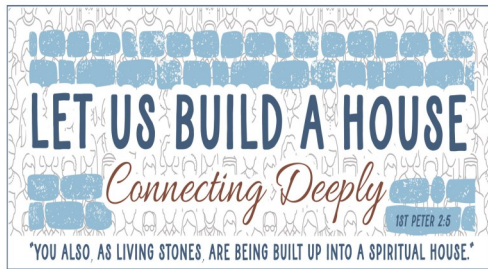


LOC Monthly Income - Actual versus Budget

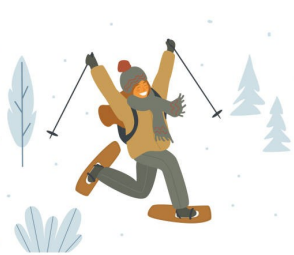
