



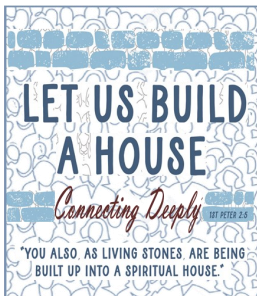

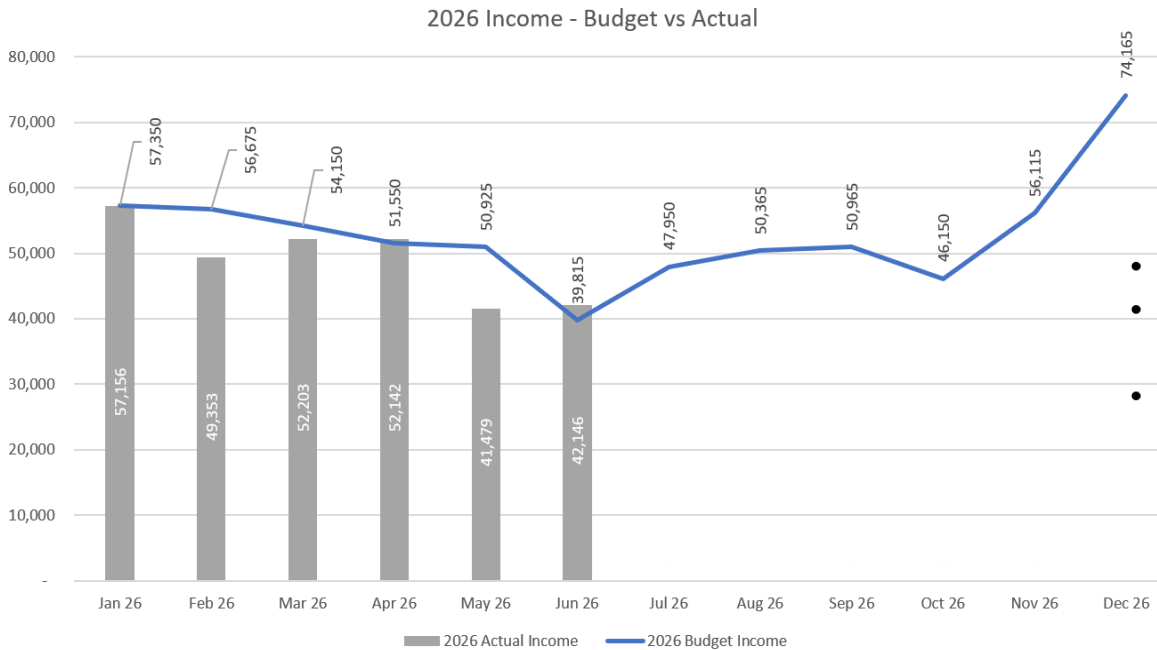

The Generous Life: Six Practices that Shape Our Faith



The Generous Life: Give Generously

Generosity invites us to trust God more deeply.

Giving generously isn't about equal amounts—it's about meaningful response. It's asking, "*What is generous for me?*" and taking a step in faith.

Throughout the Bible, generosity reflects trust—that God will provide, that our gifts matter, and that God is at work through them.

What this looks like in everyday life:

A person looks at their current giving and senses an invitation to grow. Maybe it's increasing their offering, responding to a need, or stepping beyond what feels comfortable. Over time, generosity expands.

Generosity stretches us—but it also fills us with purpose and joy.

Donor Advised Funds (DAFs) for flexible giving over time

A donor advised fund can be a great "give now, decide later" tool. You make an irrevocable contribution to a DAF, receive a tax deduction in the year you give, and then recommend grants to charities over time. This is helpful if you want to be generous in a high income year but spread out your actual gifts to churches and nonprofits across future years. It can also simplify recordkeeping by turning many future donations into one contribution for tax reporting purposes. DAFs are often described as having some of the benefits of a private foundation without as much administrative work. The tradeoff is that once assets go into the DAF, they are no longer yours, and the sponsoring organization oversees the account and investments.
