


Blue Christmas Service December 18th at 7:00 PM

Parking Lot Update


This past summer, we were eager to get started with repairs to the existing parking lot. The plan at that time was to do a cheaper and less aggressive mill and overlay option which included small soil corrections at the really bad portions of the existing asphalt. During a pre-construction site visit early this summer with the contractor, it was determined that due to the significant break-up of the existing asphalt over the

winter, we were no longer able to move forward with the mill and overlay option and needed to pursue a more aggressive approach. This includes a full soil correction down 16" on the south half of the parking lot with type 5 geotextile fabric on top of the new soil which helps the new asphalt move as one which reduces the risk of future cracks and broken up asphalt. We are excited to be moving forward with this more robust approach, but unfortunately this change delayed getting the work done this year due to contractor availability. The new parking lot is scheduled to be installed in the spring of 2026. We appreciate your patience and understanding.
