



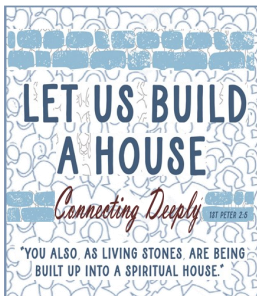

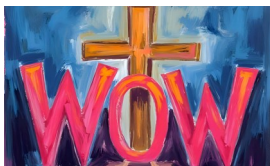
Discussion Group for Moms of Pre-Teens/Teens

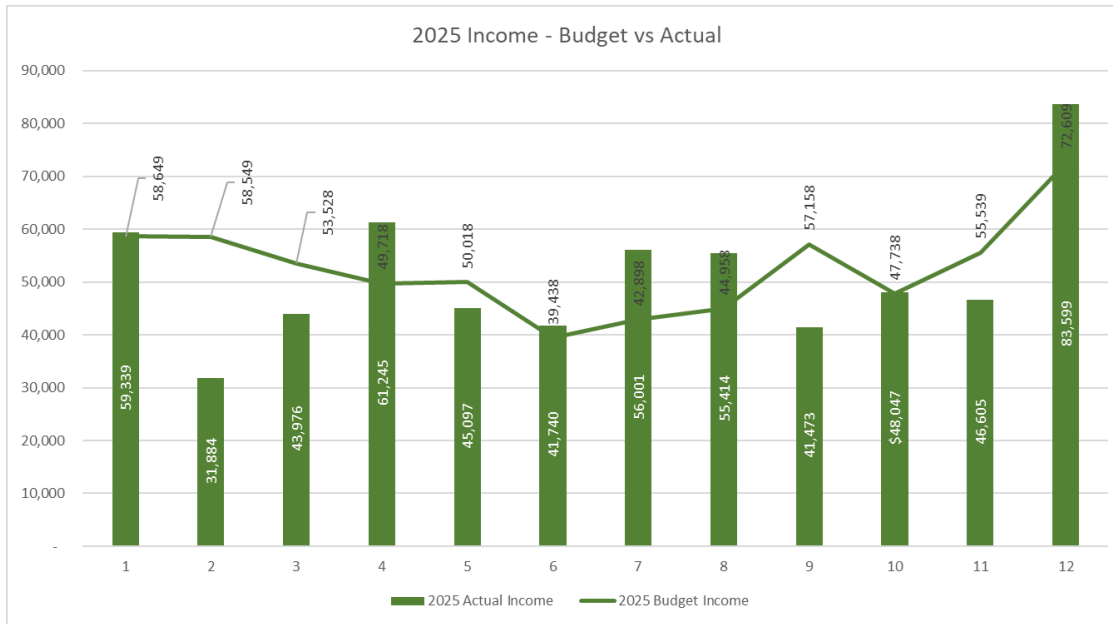

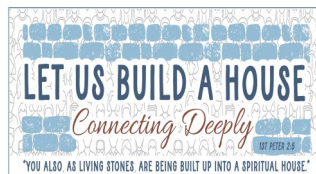

Capital Appeal Update

Thanks to your generosity, \$246,535 has been pledged to the “Let Us Build a House” capital appeal, with \$82,559 still expected during the remaining pledge period. This spring, we will move forward with rebuilding and repaving the parking lot. At \$173,000, the project is larger than anticipated, but it is essential for safety, accessibility, and welcoming all who come to Light of Christ. With more than a year of pledged giving still ahead, we also welcome anyone who would like to contribute to the capital appeal, even without a formal pledge.
