I have served four congregations over my thirty-five years as a pastor: Lutheran Church of the Master in Edina; Granite Falls Lutheran Church in Granite Falls, MN; Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Los Alamos, NM; and Light of Christ. Each congregation has been wonderful in its own unique way and I count it a privilege and a blessing to serve each one. Thank you for all you do, and even more, for all you are. You are a gift to Cynthia and me. I am profoundly grateful to God. I can say with the psalmist: “My cup runneth over . . .”

STAFFING UPDATE . . .

The Search Committees for our new Worship and Music Director and our new Associate Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministries have been hard at work this past month interviewing prospective candidates. We have been pleased with the quality of the candidates who have applied for these positions and we hope to have a decision, and make an offer, sometime in July. Ideally, we’d like to have both of these new staff members on board and at work in August. Please continue to keep the Search Committees, the candidates, the Council, and the congregation as a whole in your prayers, as we seek to discern the will of the Holy Spirit for us as we make these staffing decisions.

FIRST COMMUNION

One of our four major strategic initiatives is to strengthen our worship and music ministry. One of the steps we are planning to take in that regard is to begin lowering the age of First Communion. Right now, our children receive their First Communion in fourth grade. The plan is to have our children receive their First Communion at a significantly younger age. The fundamental reason that we are initiating this change is that we believe that receiving Holy Communion strengthens our faith, no matter what age we happen to be. In the Small Catechism Martin Luther writes that Holy Communion bestows the benefits of “forgiveness, life, and salvation.” We want these spiritual blessings to be bestowed upon our children as early as possible.

Before we actually make this change we want to address a number of questions that naturally come up when we talk about First Communion. What is our current practice? Why fourth grade? What has been our history – at Light of Christ, in the Lutheran Church, and in the wider church in general? Why, or why not, commune at a younger age? What is the current practice in the Lutheran Church, and in other churches? What does it mean to be “ready” to receive Holy Communion? What does the Bible say about First Communion? How and when are we going to make this change?

In the months ahead we will be addressing these questions, in addition to any other questions that emerge. We have a First Communion Task Force that is comprised of Aaron Amdor, Melissa Hillmyer, Gina Nee, Kirsten Kelly, our Director of Children, Youth, and Family Ministry, and me. Please don’t hesitate to contact any member of the Task Force with any questions, concerns, or comments you may have. And again, please keep this initiative in your prayers as we seek to strengthen and deepen the faith our children have in our Savior and Lord.

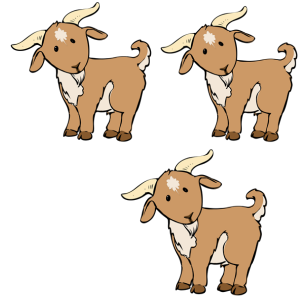
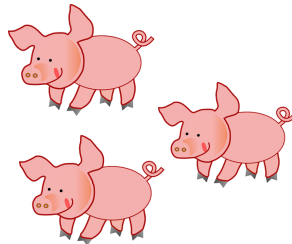
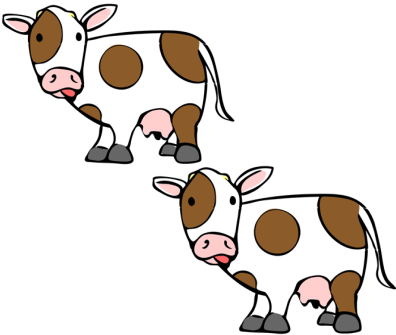

July is a busy month for our youth here at Light of Christ! Amidst weekly bonfires and other fellowship events, we are heading off on our Mission Trip and our High-Adventure Wilderness Trip! These trips are designed to bring our youth closer to God through service and experiences in creation, and for many, they prove to be the highlight of their summers!

A group of nine 9th-12th grade girls are heading out to Custer, SD July 14th-19th for the annual Light of Christ Mission Trip. We will be staying at Outlaw Ranch Camp and partnering with the Forest Service and other non-profits in the area to work on trail maintenance, building projects, and food security issues. Alongside our service work, we will have a day to explore the Black Hills area by hiking up Black Elk Peak (formerly known as Harney Peak)! We will be working for around 8 hours each day, and in the evenings we'll have bible study, devotions, campfires, and camp games/activities! We're unbelievably excited to serve a community in need and grow closer to each other and God in our week out in South Dakota.

Our High-Adventure Wilderness Trip will be in northwestern Montana this year! We'll be taking a group of six high school boys out to Flathead Lutheran Bible Camp for a week of rock climbing, kayaking, white-water rafting, and hiking in and around Glacier National Park! Spending time in nature creates an appreciation for all of God's rich blessings, and I'm so excited to share this wonderful part of the country with our youth. We'll literally be walking in faith with each other, and I can't wait to see the growth that occurs from spending time in God's creation.

DOG DAYS OF SUMMER

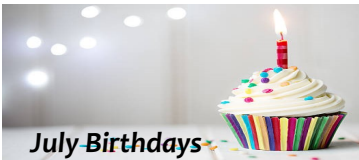
