What is the Pennsylvania Early Learning Policy Fellowship?

With generous support of the Grable Foundation, a Pittsburgh-based foundation, the Office of Child Development and Early Learning (OCDEL) is continuing the OCDEL Policy Fellowship. During a time of excitement and renewed focus on early childhood education across the state, the Fellowship will explore the many components of Pennsylvania's comprehensive early childhood system.

Fellows will develop a deep understanding of, and increased ability to navigate, the complex mechanisms that comprise an integrated, high-quality early learning system and become a part of an integral talent pool of early childhood leaders. Fellows will leave the program with the critical internal and external leadership skills necessary to lead in government and better serve children and families across the state.

Fellows will be contributing to the work of an OCDEL initiative from September 2019 through June 2020. Once a month, Fellows will come together in Harrisburg for in-person learning at a cohort meeting. Fellows will spend an additional day in Harrisburg each month working on a project that directly contributes to the work of OCDEL. This project development will occur at their placement site, which may be any one of the OCDEL Bureaus or partner organizations, with the support of a mentor.
