FREE Family Peer Support Specialist Supervisors Training

Pennsylvania is pleased to offer the Family Peer Support Specialist Supervisors training for those who are supervising the Family Peer Support Specialist (FPSS) workforce. A Family Peer Support Specialist (FPSS) is a person who is or has been the primary caregiver of an individual which includes children, youth or young adults experiencing emotional, behavioral or co-occurring challenges who inspires hope in family/caregivers. They promote empowerment, self-determination, understanding, coping skills, advocacy, education, development of natural supports, multi-system and services navigation, crisis management support, skills training, and effective utilization of services, or other meaningful activity of the families choosing

This is a 3-day comprehensive training using the Family-Run Executive Director Leadership Association (FREDLA) Parent Peer Support Practice Model: Supervision and Support of the PPSP curriculum. Lived experience as a caregiver is not required to participate in this training. The supervisor curriculum provides an overview of the PPSP Practice Model training. The training focuses on skills needed to effectively supervise and support the Family Peer Support Specialist (FPSS) workforce. Each participant will receive a certificate of completion for attending the training. There is no certification for supervisors of Family Peer Support Specialist.

Skill sets in the practice model include:

- * Creating a supportive environment
- * Ensuring fidelity and accountability to the FPSS role
- * Providing opportunities for growth and development
