Teaches students that positive actions result in good feelings. Outcomes range from increased academic achievement to lowered problem behaviors.

Project TND

Project Towards No Drug Abuse lowers risk factors for substance use & increases healthy coping skills.

- Accurate knowledge about the effects of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs (ATOD)
- Personal committments to stop or reduce ATOD use

SSET

Support for Students Exposed to Trauma reduces distress resulting from traumatic experiences.

- Addresses risk factors leading to anxiety, isolation, depressed mood, and impulsive or risky behaviors
- Builds skills to deal with stressors and to relax

We Know BETter

Designed to teach students about risky behaviors that can lead to addiction, including gambling. Addresses:

- Media literacy; sports betting; gambling myths
- Decision making and refusal skills
