- The nominee is not seeking elected office this year.
- The nominee lives, works/volunteers in the 18 counties served by Girl Scouts of Western Washington.



Audio/Video Submission Guidelines

- Submit a short (3-5 minute), cell-phone quality video (*no need for state-of-the-art technology*)
- Production-quality videos will not be a deciding factor in the selection process
- **Videos/Audio over five minutes will not be considered**
- Videos must be submitted via YouTube, Vimeo, Google Link or some other video hosting platform.
