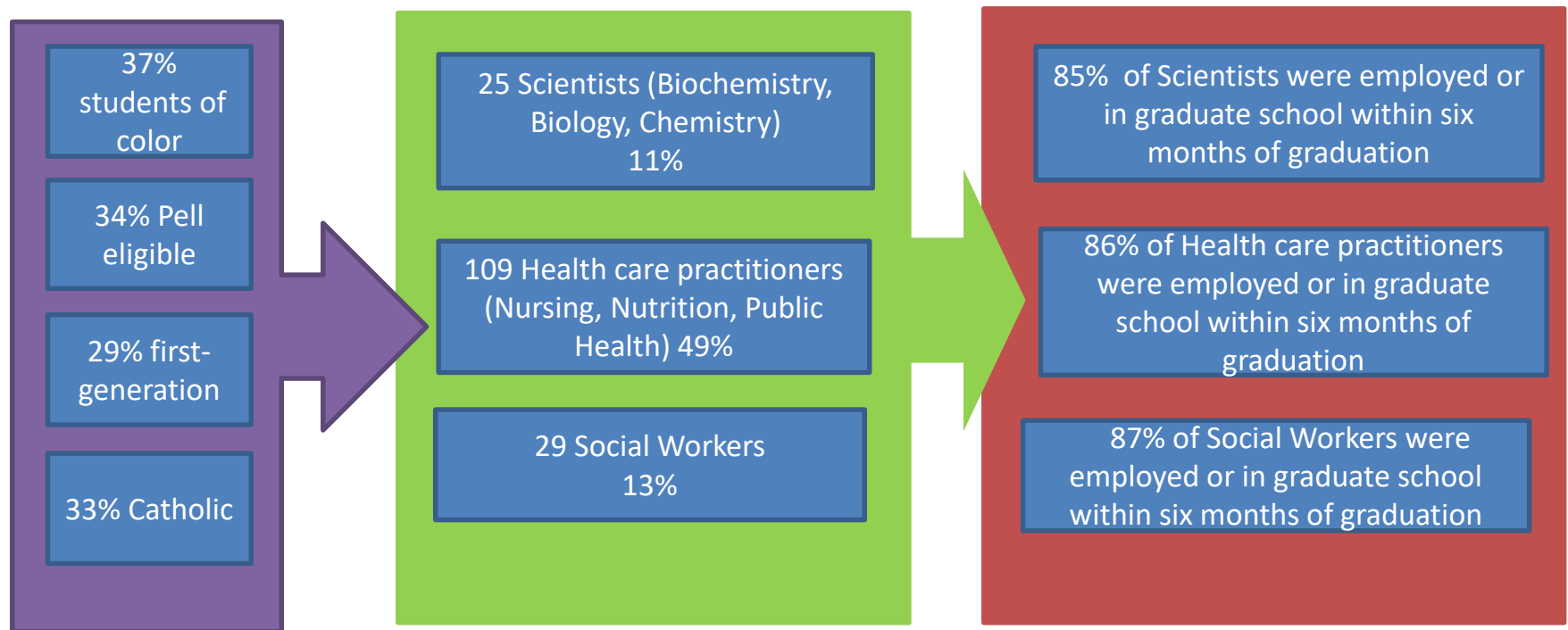

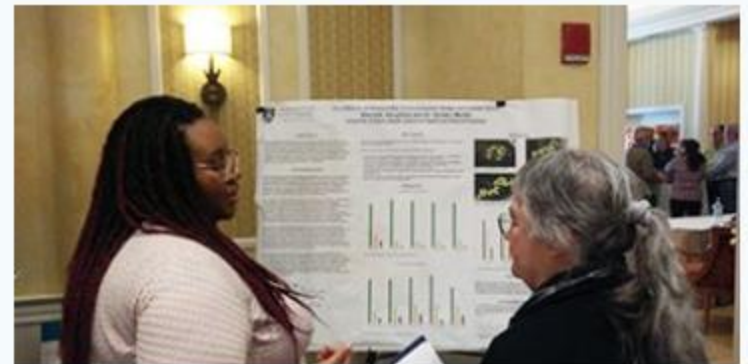

Admissions for Fall 2018

Deposits are due on May 1.

As of 4/10:

- Applications up 81%
- Female applications up 27%
- Deposits up 58% (68% female)
- Transfer applications up 77%
- Transfer deposits up 24%



Admissions (continued)

As of 4/10:

- Accepted students represent 33 states and 23 countries.
- There are 23 Honors students deposited.
- Male student athletes are deposited in swimming/diving, basketball and soccer, with 12 soccer deposits toward a goal of 16.
