Review Vaccine Ordering Guidance

COVID-19 Vaccine Distribution, Administration, Storage and Handling

Under the New York City (NYC) Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) COVID-19 Vaccination Program, vaccine distribution will be prioritized to promote equity and social and economic wellbeing, and will also prioritize individuals at greatest risk of exposure to and/or severe illness from COVID-19.

Initial distribution of the Pfizer and Moderna COVID-19 vaccines is expected to begin in mid-December 2020, after Emergency Use Authorization has been approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA). Shortly after the Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP) releases its recommendations for the use of COVID-19 vaccine, vaccination activities will commence.

Vaccine supply is initially expected to be limited but will expand over the following months such that supply will meet demand. When vaccines are available, and you have submitted your vaccine order, you will receive partial shipments of vaccine based on supply and your facility's storage capacity. As vaccine is administered and more vaccine is allocated, additional vaccine will be shipped.

Please verify the storage unit data displayed below. If the storage unit information needs to be updated, or if you did not have ultracold storage units onsite when you completed the COVID-19 Vaccination Program Provider Agreement, but have since obtained these units, be sure to update the storage unit information in the COVID-19 Vaccination Provider Agreement System (VPAS) in the Citywide Immunization Registry's (CIR's) Online Registry at www.nyc.gov/health/cir.

COVID-19 Ordering Guidance

Please submit an order for all the COVID-19 vaccine you will need for all of your health care personnel and patients.

At this time, we ask that you estimate your order amount based on the **first dose needed for each individual**.

At a later time, you will be asked to submit an order for the 2nd dose for each individual. (Note: you may change these numbers at any time as needed.)

Please refer to the estimated number of Influenza vaccine doses administered by your site during the 2019-2020 season displayed below as a guide to help you estimate how many doses to pre-book. This information was entered by your facility during the completion of your COVID-19 Vaccination Program enrollment.

Identify and communicate with your high-risk personnel for the initial vaccine shipments

The first group to be vaccinated will be your high-risk personnel. Please be sure to identify these individuals and communicate your plan for when you expect to begin offering COVID-19 vaccine. We ask that you implement an appointment schedule to make it possible to complete the first dose of the vaccine series for your high-risk personnel within 10 days.

Note: Kits with ancillary supplies needed to administer COVID-19 vaccine will be included with each vaccine shipment. Ancillary kits will include needles, syringes, alcohol prep pads and certain PPE. Ancillary Kits will be automatically ordered in amounts to match vaccine orders. There is no need for providers to order these supplies in anticipation of administering the vaccine.

However, if your site would like to opt-out of receiving the kit, please indicate your preference below. Also, for facilities receiving Pfizer vaccine, you will have the option to receive a dry ice shipment and kit to recharge the thermal shipping container within the first 24 hours if you intend to use the thermal shipping container to store vaccine. The CDC will send additional dry ice for the first replenishment order. If you have an ultra-cold freezer for vaccine storage and plan to transfer vaccine to your ultra-cold freezer upon receipt, you will not need the dry ice and can opt out.


