



#### The Distinguished Service Award

The 2024 recipient of the ISA Distinguished Service Award is Dr. Ori Gottlieb. #### Keynote Speakers at the House of Delegates



Stephen Estime, MD, Assistant Professor, Director for Diversity, Equity & Inclusion, Associate Program Director of the Core Anesthesiology Residency at the University of Chicago.

He emphasized that Diversity is the *recognition* that everyone has differences. Equity is *knowing* that individuals need different support structures to thrive. Inclusion is the *culture* that supports the ability to

thrive. Policies such as flexible employment, mentorship, and "affinity groups" (common groups that lend a sense of community) are part of the framework. Investments such as maternity/paternity leave, support for leadership training, and mental health support are also key elements.



Ralph Harding, DO. Carl Vinson VA Medical Center

Dr. Harding presented the progression of elements of the VA that are trying to eliminate anesthesiologists from the team-based model of Veterans' care and to move to a nurse-only model of care for surgery and critical care services. Euphemisms such as "collaborative care team" equate to care without an anesthesiologist vs. the traditional "anesthesia care team" which is inclusive of anesthesiologist and CRNA. VA

<u>anesthesiologists</u> as well as <u>ASA</u> are supporting "Safe VA Care". All anesthesiologists should be involved in this campaign, because if CRNA care becomes the norm for the VA it supports the notion that "if it is good enough for veterans it is good enough for everyone".



Don Arnold, MD, FASA is president of Western Anesthesiology Associates, Chair of anesthesiology at Mercy Hospital, St. Louis, and current ASA First Vice President.

Dr. Arnold spoke about creating value in ASA management. He emphasized the collaborative coordination of the Society and subspecialties along strategic lines and the building of membership

through strengthening state component societies. He emphasized the bipartisan nature of the ASAPAC with 49.9% and 50.1% support from Democrats and Republicans respectively. Continuing issues include the No Surprises ACt, medicare reimbursement, the AANA's push for independent practice.

Knowing your state and/or federal legislator and participating in the Legislative process can be very helpful to ISA as well. If you have a relationship with a Legislator or are willing to get to know them, the ISA can help with developing that relationship. As a constituent, your voice is more important than you may know. Your thoughts carry even more weight when the legislator knows who you are. Go to Illinoispolicy.org in order to find your state representative and senator's contact information. A simple email introducing yourself and offering your assistance for any medical-related questions they may have is a great means of starting a relationship.

#### Illinois Academy of Anesthesiologist Assistants (ILAAA Link)



Christy Sams, AA Vice President of the Illinois Academy of Anesthesiologist Assistants spoke on her involvement in the ILAAA. She became involved in advocacy when a change in her anesthesiology group in Indiana resulted in a new group taking over that did not employ AAs. Now living in Illinois she is working toward getting licensure adopted in Illinois. She thanked the ISA for its support and encouraged continued

engagement with AA legislation.

Even if you are not formally involved, the ISA and ASA will, on occasion, be sending out requests for help in contacting legislators on key pieces of legislation. Please help by responding to these requests and enlisting your anesthesia and non-anesthesia colleagues, voters in your family and friends in the effort. It has made a difference and will continue to do so. The clinical practice of anesthesia in Illinois can change on the passage of a bill that is either in favor or against your interests. Do not wake up one day to find that your practice has been irreparably altered without your input. Get involved.
