SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Currently active church members who are pursuing post-high school educational goals to the baccalaureate level are invited to apply for one of our church scholarships. Recipients may receive a scholarship for a maximum of 4 years for the Foundation Fund and the Roger and Gloria Hinz Scholarships.

Scholarships from the Margret Patterson Scholarship, the Foundation Fund and the Roger and Gloria Hinz Scholarship are made available to currently active church members with specific educational goals for the following fall.

The application for the Margret Patterson Scholarship, the Foundation Fund and the Roger and Gloria Hinz Scholarship is a four-part process involving:

- 1. Writing an essay of not more than three double-spaced typewritten pages containing the following:
 - a. A biographical sketch
 - b. A summary of the applicant's church and church-related activities
 - c. A summary of school-related / community activities
 - d. A statement of the applicant's goals concerning his/her education, career and personal life
- 2. Each applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from persons who are well acquainted with the applicant's interests and abilities. Writers of letters of recommendation may not be members of the applicant's family, members of the staff of the Heart of Longmont, First United Methodist Church, or members of the Foundation Committee.
