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
Writing the College Essay

This workshop, instructed by Catherine Strycharz, is geared toward rising seniors who will begin writing their college admission essays. The course will teach students how to respond to college essay questions, focus on developing students' ideas into an effective piece of writing, read and analyze sample college essays, and discuss the positive and negative aspects of those sample writings. Students will also receive 1-on-1 instructional time with the teacher to edit and revise their college essay. Capacity: 26

Algebra Bootcamp

Algebra teacher Altea Houle will give this week-long refresher for those students about to take Algebra II. The skills introduced in Algebra I often lay dormant during a year in Geometry. Topics range from a quick review of pre-algebra skills like operations with signed numbers and order of operations to equations of lines and factoring trinomial expressions. The skills will also serve as a preparation for those questions on the PSAT and SAT called "the Heart of Algebra." There is no textbook, but students will be expected to bring iPads and graphing calculators daily. Capacity: 25
