DAY 4: JUNE 21, 2016

Buongiorno! Another great day in Italy.....we left Florence this morning and drove south to Assisi. Assisi is a beautiful medieval town up on mount Subasio. It is also the birthplace of St. Francis. In fact it is the second Roman Catholic pilgrimage site of Italy, after the Vatican. Father Julian took the group through the Basilica that was built from 1226, after the death of St Francis. At the end of the visit we got back on the bus and drove south to the Etruscan town of Orvieto. Set on top of a Tuff stone rock, it has its origins with the Etruscans around the 6th century B.C. The Etruscans were a population that occupied Italy, way before the Roman invasion. We took a funicular to the top, then walked through the medieval town, with its clock tower, and to the outstanding Duomo. We had free time to explore, and then went to a winery, for the visit of the cellar, wine tasting and the best dinner on earth. The setting was just incredible, as well as the atmosphere....
