Stewardship

\$84,900

The membership and budget of First Presbyterian has experienced significant growth in the last six years. As our classrooms fill and fellowship spaces receive constant use for ministries such as Bravehearts, Presbyterian Community Ministry, weekly fellowship, youth, and UKirk events as well as funeral receptions and other gatherings, the realities of maintaining an aging facility cannot be denied. As you consider your pledge this year, know that great care has been taken to present a proposed budget we pray will cover routine maintenance and necessary repairs. As we look to 2022, we look to continue to follow our Ekklesia Master Plan to maintain but also improve our facility in order to nurture and grow the ministries that take place here.

Christian Education \$169,020.32

The Children and Youth Committee will continue to work towards keeping our children and youth connected to the church and to one another as we navigate the challenges of COVID-19. The focus for 2022 will be providing a safe transition back to inperson Christian education as outlined by our church's reopening plan, so that members can continue their faith journey and experience a transformational relationship with God.

Outreach/Missions \$121,422.27

The ministry of FPC Auburn extends far beyond our church's walls. Pledges support our partnerships with local & global ministries.

Property (\$100,989.88) & Welcome (\$52,370.88)

Although access to our property has been limited in 2020 and 2021, we have been working hard to adapt our facilities to the needs presented by the pandemic: touchless faucets, updated wifi and technology related to virtual worship, hand sanitizing stations, etc. In the year ahead we hope to resume the plans outlined in our Ekklesia Master Plan to create a safe and welcoming space for all to worship and grow.

\$65,087.14
