JANUARY SHIPMENTS



UKRAINE

In January, Medical Bridges loaded **seven 40-foot** maritime containers of lifesaving medical equipment bound for hospitals in Ukraine, moving through the Port of Houston, Romania, and directly into facilities repeatedly damaged by war. Every item was tested, vetted, and prepared for immediate use, made possible through trusted partners, donors, volunteers, and sponsors working together to move care where it's needed most.

NIGERIA

Medical Bridges partnered with BUILD at Texas A&M and VOOM Foundation to prepare and load a BUILD clinic destined to serve communities in need in Nigeria. Designed and built by dedicated students, these clinics reflect the power of collaboration and innovation in advancing global health, proving what's possible when partners come together with purpose. Special thanks to TNT Crane & Rigging for helping with efficient loading.



CAMEROON

Medical Bridges, in partnership with AFAB Development Association, loaded a container of medical supplies bound for Cameroon to support the AFAB Integrated Health Centre, a **50-bed facility** serving more than **4,000** people and caring for hundreds of patients each month. This shipment strengthens local healthcare delivery from maternal and child health to malaria treatment and prevention.



GLOBAL HEALTH IMPACT

CONTAINER SHIPMENTS TO UKRAINE CONTINUE

Thanks to Medical Bridges' long-standing partner, Daar Foundation, two containers of humanitarian medical aid recently arrived in Ukraine. The equipment and consumables will support healthcare providers in the Kharkiv and Chernihiv regions, where needs remain urgent.

These shipments reflect the impact of sustained partnerships and dependable supply chains, ensuring critical medical care reaches communities when and where it matters most. Together, we ensure regular medical support continues to save lives.

The ceremony honored not an ending, but a continued commitment built on trust, partnership, and the resolve to ensure healthcare workers on the frontlines are never alone.
