

Charlotte Catholic High School Uniform Code  
2020-21 School Year

*Note changes to the dress code in **bold**.*

Pants:

- **CCHS girls and boys may wear any classic-style dark navy or dark khaki-colored long pants or shorts meeting the requirements listed below. A logo on the pants is not required.** Lands' End uniform pants may still be worn and will be available in the used uniform sale.
- Shorts must be to the knee.
- Pants and shorts must be classic, "Dockers-Chino" style, and proper fit must be maintained (not skin-tight and not baggy.)
- Pants may not be "jeggings"-style or bell-bottomed.
- "Stone" (light) or "British Khaki" (green) colored pants will not be considered approved khaki-colored. Denim may not be worn.
- No cargo-style pants are permitted.

Shirts:

- School uniform shirts are available for purchase through Lands' End. All shirts must have the approved logo. When ordering through the Lands' End website, search for Charlotte Catholic High School. Our school number for search purposes is 900144239.
- **Shirts must be an appropriate fit and may or may not be tucked in. If a shirt is not tucked in, it should fall to a few inches below the waistband. Oversized shirts are not permitted.**
- No long-sleeved shirts may be worn under the short-sleeved uniform shirts.
- Oxford shirts may be tucked in, and an appropriate dress tie may be worn.

Sweatshirts, Sweaters and Vests:

- Uniform-approved sweatshirts, sweaters and vests may be worn over a uniform shirt. Shirrtails must not hang below the sweatshirt bottom.
- Sweaters and vests must be purchased from Lands' End. All sweaters and vests must have the approved logo.
- Uniform-approved sweatshirts, and outerwear may be purchased from Addlogos or Brand RPM. All sports teams' jackets and sweatshirts must be approved.
