Program Description:

Student Ambassadors are 10th-12th grade students who represent Charlotte Catholic High School to prospective students and parents, as well as the community. Student Ambassadors will be visible at many campus events throughout the year. They will have the opportunity to develop and receive training in leadership, public relations, interpersonal and communication skills.

Qualifications:

Student Ambassadors should be friendly, knowledgeable about the school environment, and eager to welcome new students to our community. They will uphold and represent the ideals of Charlotte Catholic. Ambassadors may be nominated by teachers or they may self-nominate. Applicants will be evaluated based on the following qualities:

- Empathy
- Motivation
- Work Ethic
- Involvement

We are especially excited to have ambassadors who have been new students themselves and are willing to share their own experiences!

- Rising freshman orientation
- Individual school tours

Requirements:

Student Ambassadors will be asked to actively participate in events and conduct all ambassador actions in a professional manner. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the position. All ambassadors are required to volunteer for at least two events throughout the year.
