Tuesday, May 25

Baccalaureate Mass

5:00 p.m.

All family members and friends may now attend Baccalaureate Mass.

The Mass will still be live-streamed for families. The live stream link is on the school calendar.

When seniors arrive, they should enter the Church and go directly to the assigned student section. They may sit with appropriate social distance in any pew.

Attire: Seniors should wear dress clothing under graduation gown but no cap. Gentlemen may wear light colored dress shirt with tie, dress slacks, dress shoes and be clean shaven with no earrings. Ladies may wear a dress of modest and appropriate length and neck line. No flip flops, spaghetti straps, strapless, halter tops, etc. are to be worn. Flip flops, tennis shoes, sports shirts, jeans, shorts, etc. are inappropriate.

Senior Awards Ceremony

The ceremony will still be live-streamed for families.

Attire: Gentlemen may wear dress slacks with a dress shirt, dress shoes, be clean shaven and wear no earrings. Ladies may wear a dress of modest and appropriate length and neck line or dress slacks and blouse. No flip flops, spaghetti straps, strapless, halter tops, etc. are to be worn.

Friday, May 28

Graduation Ceremony

Bojangles Coliseum

All family members and friends may now attend graduation. Graduation will still be live-streamed for extended family.

Graduates are to be at the Bojangles Coliseum no later than 4:30 p.m. Graduates will enter Bojangles and go directly to their seat. Graduates will sit in alphabetical order and a sticker with the graduate's name will be placed on the assigned chair. All chairs will be placed according to the approved distance.

Attire: Dress clothes as noted in the Baccalaureate section above are to be worn under cap and gown.

Guidelines for events at Bojangles Coliseum

- Security will be present and all guests asked to open pocketbooks/bags for inspection.
- The following is not permitted in the Coliseum: Balloons, banners, flowers, gifts, duffle bags, fanny packs, packages, inflatable toys, food and beverage, video cameras, plastic or "silly string."
- Noisemakers are prohibited.
