

Statement Against ICE Raids in Minnesota and Across the Nation

1/26/2026

We stand in solidarity with the people of Minnesota and communities across the country in opposing ICE raids that are cruel, unlawful, and carried out without due process. We stand with the brave protesters and neighbors who have put themselves at risk to protect one another. We condemn the killings in detention centers and the executions carried out in public view, including those of Renée Nicole Good, Alex Pretti, Keith Porter, Josué Castro Rivera, and Silverio Villegas González. Even as these killings unfold before our eyes, the Administration continues to deny and distort the truth.

We mourn the lives lost to ICE violence and hold their families in our hearts.

We stand firmly against racial profiling, the targeting of immigrant families, and unlawful deportations that disproportionately harm undocumented people, including undocumented LGBTQ+ people, BIPOC LGBTQ+ people, and trans people of color, many of whom fled persecution in their home countries. As LGBTQ+ people, families, and allies, we know what it means to be targeted, criminalized, and dehumanized.

Here in California, we have witnessed ICE raids at homes, workplaces, schools, and court hearings. The increasing militarization of ICE has not made communities safer, it has terrorized families, threatened health and livelihoods, and put lives at risk.

Our diversity is our strength. Even as we grieve, we recognize this as a defining moment that calls us to lead with love and to stand for justice, liberation, dignity, and inclusion.

We are guided by the resilience of our elders and ancestors, by those who taught us to protest, to resist oppression, and to refuse silence in the face of injustice.

Because of that legacy, we call on elected officials to oppose ICE agents terrorizing our communities. We commit to keeping our communities safe in California and beyond, extend our solidarity to the people of Minnesota and elsewhere, and demand that ICE leave our neighborhoods and communities.
