Analyze the profession of the project manager, and how it's impacted by Project Management Institute (PMI).

PROJECT MANAGEMENT: SCHEDULE AND COST MANAGEMENT

The Cost Management processes covered include Plan Cost Management, Estimate Costs, Determine Budget, and Control Costs.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT: STAKEHOLDER & COMMUNICATION MANAGEMENT

The Project Communications processes covered include Plan Communications Management, Manage Communications, and Monitor Communications.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT: LEADERSHIP & PROJECT RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

The Procurement Management processes covered include Plan Procurement Management, Conduct Procurements, Control Procurements, and Close Procurements.
