Campus Endowment Awards

The CMC Foundation distributes \$50,000 in matching funds (\$25K from Alpine Bank and \$25K from the CMC Foundation) into campus scholarship endowments as prizes for participation and giving.

All campuses are awarded a share of the award based on place: \$35,000 is awarded based on participation rates and \$15,000 is awarded in total for average gift size.
