

The Waseca County Sheriff's Office and Waseca County Emergency Management remind you all to consider signing up for the Code Red Emergency Notification System. Sign up is simple and easy by following the link on the Waseca County website: <https://www.co.waseca.mn.us/> then click on the Code Red Tab. You can sign-up for both your primary residence and a secondary address as your business so you will receive notification based on both locations. Notifications are typically location based, so signing up at your business and your home address can provide you protection in both locations. Notifications allow you to receive immediate severe weather notifications such as flooding, tornado warnings, snow storms and other severe weather, along with Emergency Notifications from the City of Waseca and throughout Waseca County. Code Red is also utilized for a number of other types of notifications that could impact the safety of the public. Code Red Emergency notification system is considered an opt-in system, so you do have to sign up to receive Code Red alerts in most instances. The only persons that may get Code Red notifications without sign-up, are those that have landline phones.

We do utilize Code Red on a number of occasions throughout the year to push out our safety messages and other alerts. We would encourage everyone to sign-up with a managed account, so we can help to provide public safety messages to you, your loved ones, and your business customers throughout the year.
