##### **Brother Outsider — The Life of Bayard Rustin**

Pride Month ends with Rev. Tim's showing of the acclaimed documentary *Brother Outsider*. The film explores the life of Bayard Rustin, one of the most controversial figures of the Civil Rights Movement. He was one of the first "freedom riders," an advisor to Dr. Martin Luther King, and a key organizer of the 1963 March on Washington. He was denied his place in the limelight for one reason—he was gay. His homosexuality forced him to play a background role in landmark events in the struggle for equal rights for African Americans.

Join Rev. Tim for one of the most powerful documentary films ever produced. The Water Protectors at Standing Rock in North Dakota captured world attention through their peaceful resistance to the Dakota Access Oil Pipeline. *AWAKE—A Dream from Standing Rock* captures the inspiring and heartbreaking story of Native-led defiance that forever changed the fight for clean water, our environment and the future of our planet. With echoes of some of police department reactions to the recent BLM uprising, witness North Dakota's violent response to the peaceful Water Protectors as they are attacked with mace, pepper spray and rubber bullets at point-blank range. This film not only shows a brutal repression of a peaceful protest, it is also a compilation of

emotional interviews with members of the camp responding to having their civil liberties trampled on.

### **The Untold Story of Emmett Till**

Eight days later he would be abducted and murdered for violating one of the oldest Southern taboos: whistling at a white woman in public. This groundbreaking film is the result of a 10-year journey to uncover the truth behind the nightmarish murder of an innocent African-American teenager and a major impetus for America's civil rights movement.
