CERT training promotes an effort on preparedness between emergency management and the people they serve, targeting:

- Non Profit Organizations.

CERT members are then integrated into the emergency response capability for their area. If a disastrous event overwhelms or delays the community's professional response, CERT members can assist others by applying the basic response and organizational skills they learned during training. These skills can help save and sustain lives following a disaster until help arrives. CERT skills also apply to daily emergencies and builds resiliency in the communities.
