The Coalition's candidate recommendations are nonpartisan – they're based exclusively on which candidates will be most supportive of fair funding and autonomy for public charter schools, regardless of political party.

Lindalyn Kakadelis, Executive Director of the N.C. Coalition for Charter Schools, said, **"Public charter schools are part of the public school family. These candidates support public charter schools so that all families, not just the select few, can have a choice in their children's schooling. If you care about education and school choice, we recommend you support these candidates."**

Public charter schools are a wildly popular option for families seeking the best educational fit for their children. Over the past decade, the statewide population of public charter school students has tripled.

A [recent report](#) from the National Alliance for Public Charter Schools, which included national polling data, confirms that parents prefer a choice in education. More than four in five parents (83%) agree that education has become a more important political issue to them than it was in the past, and 82% are willing to vote outside their party on the issue of education.
