We are learning:

In Foundations, we will learn about digraph blends er/ir/ur and the letter sounds ar & or. In Secret Stories, we will learn about oo, ey & ay sounds. In Reading, we will talk about main topic, retelling key details of a text, describing connections between two texts, using text features to locate information, and show in a passage where we found our information. We will also compare & contrast two experiences, learn about sequence of events, and make predictions. In ELA, we will review ending marks and introduce pronouns.

In writing, we will talk about persuasive writing.

In science, we will learn about clouds. We will also learn about what causes day and night, as well as why do we see the sky at night. In Social Studies, we will learn about MLK, Abraham Lincoln, and goods & services.

In Math, we will learn about solving real-world problems involving addition and subtraction within 20. We will talk about adding to, taking from, putting together, taking apart, and comparing by using objects, drawings and equations. In Religion, we will learn about Jesus and His Apostles, how Jesus showed God's love, and learn about St. Francis Xavier and St. Jude.
