Raise Right Gift Card Fundraiser

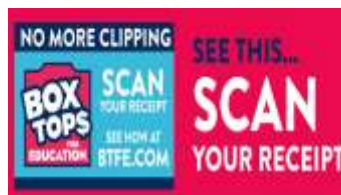

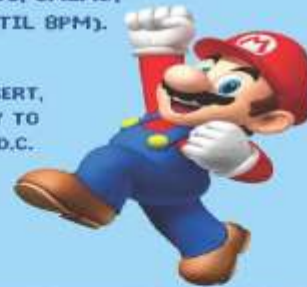
