## For 3 Year Olds: 3s Preschool

- **Age requirement:** Child must turn 3 by Aug. 1 and be potty trained by start of school
- Class meets Tuesday, Wednesday, & Thursday from 9 a.m. to noon
- Extended day option available from noon-2:45 p.m. (tuition rate doubles for this option). May opt in or out of this option at semester break.
- Before-care available from 7:30 a.m. to 9 a.m. for additional fee.

## For 4 Year Olds: Pre-Kindergarten

- **Age requirement:** Child must turn 4 by Aug. 1
- Saint Matthew School offers a 3-day per week option (M-W-F), or a 5-day per week option.
- Classroom time: 9 a.m.-2:45 p.m.
- Before-care and after-care available for additional fees.
