Reading

<u>Reading</u>: This week we read a story called *Big Blue Whale*. Throughout the story, students learned interesting facts abut blue whales. This week we are beginning a new chapter book called *Fourth Grade Rats* by Jerry Spinelli.

Writing & Math

Writing: This week in writing, we discussed the -e rule which is when a word end in -e, drop the -e before adding a suffix that begins with a vowel. Students also practiced identifying verbs and using singular possessives correctly in sentences. Next week we will be continue our spiral review focusing more on compound words, plural possessive nouns, understanding verbs and prefix's, and the use of apostrophes too.

<u>Math</u>: In math, we wrapped up our discussion on multiplication and division, exploring how the two operations are related. Students reviewed all of the skills learned throughout Unit 3. Next week, we will begin **Unit 4** which focuses on using patterns to multiply by 2's, 5's, 10's, and 1 and 0.

Social Studies

Social Studies: This week in Social Studies, we reviewed and ested our knowledge of culture--what it is and why it natters. We began discussing how culture connects to life in the United States. Students shared their thoughts on what it neans to have different cultures within one country and how leliefs and customs are observed. We will continue to explore the Essential Question: How does diversity influence ulture?

Science

In science, we explored sunspots, learning that they are considered storms on the sun. We expanded our discussion to include the cause and effect of how sunspots impact Earth. Students also began learning about the paths of the sun's energy and how energy from the sun and wind can be used to produce electricity.
