
First Grade Newsletter — August Edition

Welcome to a New School Year!

What a great week we've had! I've barely had a chance to catch my breath, but that's a great thing! If you have not sent in a family photo or headphones with your child, please do so at your earliest convenience.

² I am so excited to welcome our first-grade students and families to an exciting year of learning, discovery, and fun! August will be full of new routines, friendly faces, and foundational skills that will guide us through the months ahead.



In reading, we will review letters and sounds, with a focus on:

Tt-Bb-Ff, Nn-Mm, Ii-Uu, Cc-Oo

We'll practice letter-keyword-sound routines, as well as handwriting and letter formation. In writing, we'll launch our writing block by discussing prewriting strategies and gathering ideas. We'll also begin using a comprehension strategy called Stop-Think-Paraphrase to strengthen our understanding.



This month, we will explore how things go together, patterns, and "What Doesn't Belong?" activities to build number sense and reasoning. We will also do pre-assessments this year before we begin our chapters to gauge where the students are currently with their math skills and use that to guide our instruction.

Math homework will be assigned nightly to help reinforce concepts learned in class. We ask that you please complete this as it informs you what we are learning, allows you to monitor your child's progress, and establishes good HW habits as they move forward on their academic journey at Saint Matthew.



We'll begin the year learning about God, our Father, and how we pray. Students will explore their faith through prayer and stories.

Social Studies & Science

In social studies, we're learning about timelines and how our personal histories and the histories of others unfold. In science, we will explore living vs. nonliving things through hands-on observation and discussion.
